BREAST CANCER SCREENING	The program encourages women between the ages of 50-74 to be screened every two years at one of the 16 mammography sites across the province. Women residing in NB who are 50 - 74 years of age and have no signs, symptoms or previous diagnosis of breast cancer can self-refer to breast cancer screening by contacting one of the screening sites. Women aged 40-49 or over 74 who have no signs, symptoms or previous diagnosis of breast cancer require a referral from a primary health-care provider.
